The Laws of Life Essay Contest asks students in grades 9-12 to self-reflect and write about ethical principles that will help them develop leadership skills and their character. And in the process, they will learn more about themselves and what they stand for after reading the *Uncommon*Sense® FRAMEWORK. Plus, it gives teachers the opportunity to really get to know their students and encourage empathy and compassion.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The Laws of Life Essay contest is open to schools with students in grades 9-12 in the following counties:

Summit, Portage, Wayne, Richland, Ashland and Medina.

The students are asked to self-reflect and write about ethical principles that will help them develop leadership skills and their character.

IS THERE A SPECIFIC LENGTH?

Essays should be no more than three typed, double spaced pages.

HOW ARE ESSAYS JUDGED?

Essays are judged primarily on content, a sample judging rubric is provided on the website.
