

These funds play a vital role in bolstering community programs and offering grant support to small businesses within the 45 counties BBB serves.



















TORNADO RELIEF

On the afternoon and evening of December 9, 2023, severe storms brewed across Middle Tennessee and Southern Kentucky, heralding a robust cold front. Three primary supercell tracks traversed portions of the region, spawning a total of 7 tornadoes.

Communities such as Clarksville, Nashville, Hendersonville, and Gallatin bore the brunt of the devastation, with numerous injuries, fatalities, and widespread damage to homes and businesses.

Responding swiftly, Better Business Bureau (BBB) mobilized to aid affected businesses. Formulating a comprehensive plan, two teams were deployed to facilitate business recovery efforts. One team concentrated on providing assistance to the Hendersonville and Gallatin areas, while the other focused on aiding Clarksville.

In support of business recovery, BBB awarded three businesses with financial assistance to assistance them during the rebuilding process.
