## 2018 Programs & Accomplishments

#### **Ethics in Action Program**

The Ethics in Action program is designed to raise ethical principles and behaviors among youth.

Launched a new ethics program designed to engage a younger audience and introduce them to BBB's eight Standards of Trust: Build Trust, Advertise Honestly, Tell the Truth, Be Transparent, Honor Promises, Be Responsive, Safeguard Privacy and Embody Integrity.
