OUR IMPACT

Spreading Joy to Seniors during the pandemic was an important way to give back to the community in 2020. We offered three socially distant Mid-Day Music with BBB concerts for those living in long term care communities.

A Virtual Cybersecurity Summit was held as a 3-part series in May, and we hosted a Cybersecurity Fireside Chat Q and A in October. Presenters were Hatcher Insurance Agency, Mitchell Williams Law Firm, Edafio Technology Partners, and an FBI Representative. Janet Robb made opening remarks and moderated the the panel discussion.

The Torch Awards were held September 10, 2020 at the Governor's Mansion and for the first time virtually with over 200 people in attendance. Mike Moore, Partner at Friday, Eldredge, and Clark, was the Chair of the event. Arkansas Governor Asa Hutchinson was our keynote speaker for the afternoon. Six businesses were recognized as winners of the 2020 Torch Awards.

Our Veterans Initiative provided information for Veterans on how to spot a scam, where to do fact finding when you might be exposed to a scam, and what to do if you have a friend or family member that might be a target of a scammer.
