

Torch Awards for Ethics - a national award-winning "educate & recognize" program, is the premier public recognition of organizations that intentionally pursue the six TRUST! Principles. Torch Award alumni benefit from ongoing program support and partner with the BBB to showcase and share their organization's best practices on the web to inspire others to join the quest for optimal enterprising.

BBB Military Line - provides free resources to our military communities in the areas of financial literacy and consumer protection. This program protects military families from scams targeting their community.

Active Shooter Preparedness - partnered with our local branch of the FBI for Active Shooter Preparedness Training to local businesses. These 2-hour workshops focused on preparing you and your employees for an active shooter event.

OUR IMPACT

The Torch Awards were held May 2, 2019 at the Governor's Mansion with hover 200 people in attendance. Mike Allbritton, Windows USA/Window Mart, was the Chair of the event. Coach Chad Morris, Head Football coach at the University of Arkansas in Fayetteville, was our keynote speaker for the afternoon. Five businesses were recognized as winners of the 2018 Torch Awards.

Cybersecurity Summits were held April 26 in Central Arkansas and October 30 in Jonesboro, AR. Presenters were Hatcher Insurance Agency, Mitchell Williams Law Firm, Edafio Technology Partners, and an FBI Representative. Janet Robb made opening remarks and moderated the the panel discussion.

Active Shooter/Active Event Preparedness events were held September 23 and October 18 in Central Arkansas, October 30 in Searcy, AR, November 13 in South Arkansas, and December 4 in Northwest Arkansas. Our partners at the FBI answered questions and reviewed procedures designed to help businesses be prepared in the event of an active incident.
